

# Regency Road to Pym Street Project

## WORKS NOTIFICATION

April 2020



### *Stobie pole removals, Croydon Park*

As part of the R2P Project, SA Power Networks will be removing redundant stobie poles along South Road between Regency Road and Pym Street, Croydon Park.

#### **How long will the works take?**

Works will be undertaken at night between the hours of 7pm to 6am, commencing Monday 20 April 2020, until Friday 24 April 2020, weather permitting.

#### **How will the works impact me?**

During works, there will be temporary lane closures on South Road and at local streets, between Regency Road and Pym Street as the works progress. Traffic management signage and personnel will be in place each night to guide motorists and maintain local access during the works. Please take extra care when travelling through the area and observe traffic signage, speed restrictions and traffic controllers.

To replace the stobie poles that provide road lighting, temporary light towers will be placed along South Road. These will be in place for several weeks until temporary light poles can be installed. More information on road lighting will be provided closer to the time of installation.

There will be no impact to pedestrian access and public transport services during the works.
