

Regency Road to Pym Street Project

WORKS NOTIFICATION

Temporary closure of Pym Street, Croydon Park

The Regency Road to Pym Street (R2P) Project has been constructing ramps for the pedestrian and cyclist overpass near Pym Street, Croydon Park.

In early November 2020, the precast concrete stairs for the western side of the South Road overpass will be installed.

How long will the works take?

The stairs will be installed on **Monday, 2 and Tuesday, 3 November 2020, between 7am and 5pm.**

How will the works impact me?

To safely undertake the works, **Pym Street will be closed to motorists between South Road and Austin Street during the works.** Once these works are complete, Pym Street will be reopened.

Signage will be in place to advise motorists of the road closure and the detour route via Royce Avenue and Austin Street.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during these works. Access to residential properties on Pym Street will also be maintained.

Please plan ahead and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
