

Regency Road to Pym Street Project

WORKS NOTIFICATION

October 2020



Construction of Regency Road pavements, installation of cables and construction of reinforced earth walls

The Regency Road to Pym Street (R2P) Project will shortly be commencing pavement works along Regency Road, and installation of traffic cables. Works to construct reinforced earth walls for the motorway is continuing.

Where will the works be located and how long will the works take?

Works will occur along the North-South Motorway, Regency Road and South Road, Regency Park Croydon Park and Angle Park.

What type of works are happening?

Construction of Regency Road pavements

Construction of Regency Road pavements will be undertaken from mid-October 2020, between Crossley Avenue and Reo Road, and will include:

- profiling of the existing road (removal of asphalt to a suitable level),
- laying of road base and new asphalt,
- installation of kerb and gutter, and median kerbing, and
- painting of line marking.

Noise and vibration from machinery use can be expected during these works, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to local residents and businesses as much as practicably possible.

Heavy vehicles will be fitted with low level reversing squawkers, where possible, and temporary light towers will be used for night works. During profiling of the existing road, reverse beepers will be used for safety.

Works will first be undertaken between Crossley Avenue and South Road, followed by works between Reo Road and South Road. Residents will be given advance notice of any driveway restrictions.

Installation of traffic cables

Traffic cables are being installed along the North-South Motorway and South Road, between Pym Street, Croydon Park and Angle Road, Angle Park.

The cables will be installed within existing conduits, through pits within the roadways. A small crew will undertake the works using a cable pulling machine and a cable drum on a trailer.

New cables will also be installed, and existing cables removed within the road in Crossley Avenue, between Regency Road and Pym Street. Local residents will be notified prior to works commencing.

Construction of reinforced earth walls

The R2P Project is currently constructing reinforced earth walls as part of construction for the new motorway ramps. These works are being undertaken on day shifts, however, to improve efficiency, construction of the walls will also commence during afternoon and evening shifts.

Work hours and traffic management

Cable installation works will be undertaken at night from mid-October 2020, between 6pm and 6am, Sunday to Thursday. Lane and speed restrictions will be required.

Regency Road pavement works will be undertaken over approximately five weekends, starting from Friday, 16 October 2020. Profiling of the road will be undertaken on each Friday night, with road base and asphalt to be constructed and laid during the day on Saturdays and Sundays, on all weekends. These works are weather permitting, and rescheduling may be required.

The construction of the reinforced earth walls will also be undertaken between 5pm and 11pm, Monday to Friday. These works are planned from mid-October 2020, until late November 2020. Nearby residents will be notified if works are postponed, or expected to be noisy.

Noise impacts will be minimised as much as practically possible; however some noise will be unavoidable.

Traffic management and signage will be in place to alert road users to any changed traffic conditions. Road users are asked to plan ahead and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
