

# Regency Road to Pym Street Project

## WORKS NOTIFICATION

January – March 2021



### **Key construction works throughout January until March 2021**

The Regency Road to Pym Street (R2P) Project works for January until early March 2021 include ongoing works on the Regency Road overpass, motorway construction, services and gantry installation, pedestrian and cyclist overpass installation and roadworks and landscaping.

#### **Where will the works be located and how long will the works take?**

Works will occur along the North-South Motorway, Regency Road and South Road, Regency Park, Croydon Park and Angle Park.

The works will be undertaken throughout January to March 2021.

#### **What type of works will be happening?**

##### *Regency Road overpass construction*

After the centre spans and supporting structures are installed in January 2021, works on the overpass will continue at the intersection for several months.

Prior to the overpass opening, the wearing course (final layer of asphalt) will be laid. After the wearing course has been laid, the middle concrete road barriers will be installed to separate the northbound and southbound traffic.

Underneath the overpass at the intersection of South Road and Regency Road, paved feature areas, including earthworks, kerbing and paving, will be undertaken from around mid-January.

These works will be undertaken during day shifts.

##### *Motorway construction*

Works to construct the motorway will continue, with the installation of concrete road barriers and placement of pavement material for the ramps on the northern and southern sides of South Road for the overpass over Regency Road. These works will continue over the coming months.

These works will be undertaken during day and night shifts.

##### *Services and road gantries installation*

Works to connect SA Water infrastructure will be undertaken along Regency Road, between South Road and Reo Road, in mid-January 2021, for two weeks.

These works will be undertaken during night shifts.

Road gantries are the overhead structures used to support mounted Variable Message Signs, Lane Use Management Systems and Closed-Circuit Television (CCTV) (video security surveillance).

Cranes will be used to install new gantries along South Road and the North-South Motorway. Elevated work platforms will be used to modify existing gantries.

Gantries will be installed from mid-February to late March 2021. These works will be undertaken during day and night shifts.

# Regency Road to Pym Street Project

## WORKS NOTIFICATION

January – March 2021



### *Pedestrian and Cyclist Overpass installation*

In late February 2021, the Pedestrian and Cyclist Overpass will be transported to site from Bowhill Engineering. The overpass will be lifted and installed into place over South Road near Pym Street, using cranes during a weekend in late February 2021.

To safely install the overpass, major traffic restrictions will be required along South Road, between Torrens Road and Regency Road. More information, including alternate traffic routes, will be provided closer to the time of works.

### *Road works and landscaping*

Demolition of old kerb and gutter and installation of new kerb and gutter, footpaths and concrete crossovers will continue. From Monday, 4 January 2021, for four weeks, the focus area will be along South Road, between Packard Avenue and Regency Road.

Construction of the heavy vehicle bypass road into the Dudley Park Industrial Precinct will continue, with completion of the bypass road expected in March 2021, weather permitting.

Landscaping will continue over the coming months with tree planting, garden beds and turf laying.

These works will be undertaken during day shift.

### **How will the works impact me?**

Noise disturbance and vibration from machinery use can be expected while these works are completed, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practicably possible.

Heavy vehicles will be fitted with low level reversing squawkers, where possible, and temporary light towers will be used for night works. Where possible, light towers will be directed away from residences.

Day shifts will be undertaken between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday. Night shifts will be undertaken between 7pm and 6am.

Should we experience extremely hot weather conditions during the January to March 2021 period, day shifts will commence earlier at 6am. Concrete pours for the Regency Road overpass will also be undertaken from 4am.

### *Traffic Management*

Traffic management and signage will be in place to alert road users to any changed traffic conditions. Road users are asked to plan ahead and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.
