# Regency Road to Pym Street Project

## **WORKS NOTIFICATION**

February - June 2020



## Service installations and drainage, road and site compound works

As part of the Regency Road to Pym Street Project (R2P), utility services and a Common Services Trench (CST) works will continue to be installed over the coming months. With concrete road barriers also in place, the construction of site fencing, drainage and road works across the project area will commence.

#### How long will the works take? Where will they be located?

#### Service installations

The installation of a large SA Water main on Regency Road was completed in February 2020. The installation of a smaller water main along the southern side of Regency Road, between Reo Road and Crossley Avenue, will commence in May 2020, and take approximately five weeks, weather permitting.

SA Water will continue to install other important infrastructure along South Road, between Regency Road and Pym Street, Croydon Park. Additionally, other key utility infrastructure including gas, power and telecommunications, will continue to be installed along South Road, Regency Road and intersecting streets at Croydon Park and Regency Park.

The CST installation including lighting, communication and power cables, has been taking place along both sides of South Road, between Regency Road and Camira Street, Regency Park, since late 2019. These works will continue along both sides of South Road, between Regency Road and Lamont Street, Croydon Park. All CST works are expected to be completed in mid-2020, weather permitting.

Services installation works will continue over the coming months during the day and night to maintain traffic flow through the project area.

### Drainage and road works

The installation of temporary fencing and access gates to separate construction zones from the public commenced in February 2020, and is expected to be completed by mid-March 2020.

In the vacant land each side of South Road, works will commence behind the barriers to build the South Road surface roads. The location of services infrastructure, earthworks, and the installation of underground drainage systems will continue to be undertaken along South Road, Regency Road and Pym Street.

#### Site compound works

At Polonia Oval, a site compound will be established to support the Regency Road Bridge building activities and to accommodate an increase in the R2P project workforce. The Regency Road Bridge will be constructed 'offline' at this location. Constructing the bridge offline allows construction works to proceed safely away from road traffic, and maintains traffic flow and reduces impacts to motorists. #### How will the works affect me?

When major lane and speed restrictions are required, night works will be undertaken between 6pm and 6am, Monday to Sunday. Respite nights will be provided. Noise impacts will be minimised to nearby businesses and residents, however; some noise will be unavoidable.

Traffic management and signage will be in place to alert road users of any changed traffic conditions. Road users are asked to use extra caution when workers are on site, follow the direction of traffic management and observe traffic signage and speed restrictions when travelling through the area.

Speed and lane restrictions will be in place at South Road, Regency Road and adjoining local streets where construction works are being undertaken.


