Drone usage to support construction activities in Croydon Park, Regency Park and Dudley Park

To support construction activities for the Regency Road to Pym Street (R2P) Project, a drone is used weekly, until project completion.

The general flight path of the drone is along South Road, between Torrens Road and Aruma Street, and Regency Road, between Days Road and Pedder Crescent (including the Pedder Crescent loop).

Information captured in the drone flights is used for:

- inspection and monitoring of construction progress and site conditions;
- improving design and construction accuracy; and
- informing the community of project progress.

How will my privacy be protected?

Privacy filters will be in place for every drone flight. The drone is operated adhering to the rules of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority, a minimum of 30 metres away from people and 5.5 kilometres from controlled airports.

Drone footage will be used for construction and communication purposes only. Communication activities may also include the use of footage for media and social media purposes.
