

Regency Road to Pym Street Project

WORKS NOTIFICATION

March 2021



Construction works during March and April 2021

The Regency Road to Pym Street (R2P) Project works for March and April 2021, include ongoing works on the Regency Road overpass and motorway construction, traffic signal cable installation, landscaping, roadworks including asphalt works on Regency Road, and finishing works on the pedestrian and cyclist overpass near Pym Street.

Where will the works be located and how long will the works take?

Works will occur along the North-South Motorway, Regency Road and South Road, Regency Park, Croydon Park and Angle Park, throughout March and April 2021.

What type of works will be happening?

Regency Road overpass and motorway construction

Concrete road barrier and barrier rails will continue to be installed on the Regency Road overpass during March 2021.

The wearing course (a final layer of asphalt) will be laid on the overpass. After the wearing course is laid, the middle concrete road barriers will be installed to separate the northbound and southbound traffic.

These works will be undertaken during day shifts and will not require change of traffic movements.

Construction works will continue along the motorway, with painting of the ramp walls, installation of concrete road barriers and placement of pavement material for the ramps on the northern and southern sides of South Road for the overpass over Regency Road.

These works will be undertaken mainly during night shifts and weekends, and will require temporary lane and road closures along South Road and the North-South Motorway.

Traffic signal cable installation

Traffic signal cables will be installed along the South Road surface roads, North-South Motorway and Regency Road. These works require excavation of road material, installation of cables, backfill of road material and placement of asphalt.

These works will be undertaken during night shifts and will require lane and speed restrictions.

Traffic changes and alternate routes resulting from these works will be communicated via advance notice signage.

Pedestrian and cyclist overpass installation

In late February 2021, the pedestrian and cyclist overpass was installed into place over South Road near Pym Street.

Site works will continue during March 2021, to complete the overpass and open it for public access. Final works prior to the opening of the overpass include the installation of balustrades (post and rail along the sides of the overpass), fencing and lighting. The overpass is expected to open mid-March 2021.

At the same time, landscaping works along South Road near Pym Street will be undertaken. This includes installation of footpaths, light posts and permanent bus stops and shelters, as well as landscape planting.

Road works and landscaping

Demolition of old kerb and gutter and installation of new kerb and gutter and footpaths will continue along South Road, between Pym Street and Royce Avenue.

Construction of the heavy vehicle bypass road into the Dudley Park Industrial Precinct will continue, with completion of the bypass road expected in March 2021, weather permitting.

Underneath the overpass at the intersection of South Road and Regency Road, paved feature areas, including earthworks, kerb, paving and tiling will continue.

Landscaping, including tree planting, garden beds and laying of turf will continue over the coming months.

These works will be undertaken during day and night shifts and advance notice will be provided to nearby residents and businesses.

How will the works impact me?

Noise disturbance and vibration from machinery use can be expected while these works are underway, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Heavy vehicles will be fitted with low level reversing squawkers, where possible. Temporary light towers will be used for night works. Where possible, light towers will be directed away from residences.

Day shifts will be undertaken between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday. Night shifts will be undertaken between 7pm and 6am.

Should we experience extremely hot weather conditions during March and April 2021, day shifts will commence from 5am.

Traffic Management

Traffic management and signage will be in place to alert road users to any changed traffic conditions. Road users are asked to plan ahead and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

During motorway construction works along South Road and the North-South Motorway, lane and road closures will be required. When significant closures are required, the works will be undertaken at night and over weekends to minimise impacts to traffic along the major roads.
