

Regency Road to Pym Street Project

WORKS NOTIFICATION

April 2021



Construction works during April and May 2021

The Regency Road to Pym Street (R2P) Project works for April and May 2021, include asphalt works along South Road and Regency Road, traffic signal cable and light pole installation, finishing works on the pedestrian and cyclist overpass near Pym Street and landscaping and plaza works.

Where will the works be located and how long will the works take?

Works will occur along South Road and Regency Road, Regency Park and Croydon Park, throughout April and May 2021.

What type of works will be happening?

Asphalt works

Now that the Regency Road overpass is open, the R2P Project can focus on completing the wearing course (final layer of asphalt and line marking) along the South Road surface roads.

The works will be undertaken in sections along the northbound lanes of South Road, between Overland Road and the Regency Park Oval, and the southbound lanes of South Road, between Tikalara Street and Hotchkiss Crescent.

These works will be undertaken during day and night shifts and will require significant changes of traffic movements. Works will take approximately four weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Works to upgrade Regency Road, between Pedder Crescent and Days Road will include profiling of the existing road (removal of asphalt to a suitable level), laying of road base and new asphalt and painting of line marking.

These works will be undertaken mainly during night shifts and weekends, and will require temporary lane and road closures along South Road. Works will take four weeks to complete, weather permitting.

Traffic changes and alternate routes resulting from these works will be communicated via advance notice signage.

Traffic signal cable and light pole installation

Traffic signal cables will be installed along the South Road surface roads, North-South Motorway and Regency Road. These works require excavation of road material, installation of cables, backfill of road material and placement of asphalt.

Light pole installation will be undertaken next to the concrete road barriers along the North-South Motorway, between Taminga Street and Camira Street.

These works will be undertaken during day shifts and require lane and speed restrictions along the North-South Motorway and closures of the South Road surface road.

Traffic changes and alternate routes resulting from these works will be communicated via advance notice signage.

Finishing works on the pedestrian and cyclist overpass

Finishing works including completion of balustrades (post and rail along the sides of the overpass) and stairs is expected to occur during April and May 2021. The overpass will remain open to public access during these works.

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The installation of footpaths, light posts and permanent bus stops and shelters, as well as landscape planting will occur along South Road near Pym Street.

Landscaping and plaza works

Installation of new footpaths will continue along South Road, between Rugby Avenue and the Regency Park Oval, and Regency Road, between South Road and Naweena Road. All footpaths are expected to be complete by the end of April 2021, weather permitting.

In the plaza areas underneath the overpass at the intersection of South Road and Regency Road, paved feature areas, including paving and tiling will continue.

Permanent bus stops and shelters will be installed along South Road near Pym Street (both sides) and Rugby Avenue (western side), and Regency Road next to Coopers Brewery (northern side). These installations are expected to be complete by the end of April 2021, weather permitting.

Landscaping, including tree planting, garden beds and laying of turf will continue over the coming months.

These works will be undertaken during day shifts.

How will the works impact me?

Noise disturbance and vibration from machinery use can be expected while these works are underway, however, the work will be managed to minimise disturbance to nearby residents and businesses as much as practically possible.

Heavy vehicles will be fitted with low level reversing squawkers, where possible. Temporary light towers will be used for night works. Where possible, light towers will be directed away from residences.

Day shifts will be undertaken between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Sunday. Night shifts will be undertaken between 7pm and 6am.

Traffic Management

Traffic management and signage will be in place to alert road users to any changed traffic conditions. Road users are asked to plan ahead and take extra care when workers are on site. Observe speed limits, lane restrictions and traffic controllers when travelling through the area.

During South Road and Regency Road asphalt works, lane and road closures will be required. When significant closures are required, the works will be undertaken at night and over weekends to minimise impacts to traffic along the major roads.
